About the sponsor: Jane Ryan is an educator who has helped scores of young people prepare for successful, elevated lives for five decades. As a counselor, author and filmmaker she has used a variety of ways to help individuals approach and attain their educational and life goals.

During her early life in the late 1940's and early '50's Jane watched her beloved grandfather farm gnarly fields and plant his crops behind stubborn mules who pulled a worn plow. Then at 8 years old she moved from Nebraska to rural North Carolina with her family while her father served his tour as a Coast Guard pilot.

In her new home, and because of those early experiences, Ryan was drawn to the farmers who lived nearby and the fact that many were Black – people who were totally new to her – made her new friends even more interesting. She recalls that one particular family let her hang out with them and answer Jane's million questions while she learned to bottle feeding a motherless goat. Even more important, she learned firsthand that picking cotton is very painful to the hands and backs of those picking.

To this day Jane is filled with warm memories for those families who lovingly demonstrated gentle, accepting concern for her. She also believes that any positive, caring personality traits she possesses were instilled in her in the "old days" by those African American adults who were so kind to that young girl from Nebraska.

It is with a heart filled with gratitude for those experiences in rural North Carolina that Jane Ryan offers three (3) scholarships to African American students who dream of earning an education that will lead to successful careers. She calls the scholarships "Starters" because they are meant to provide that necessary first step into educational programs for qualified high school graduates whose situation may otherwise keep them from taking that first move toward their waiting adventure.

Jane often says to young people, "Dream BIG! What's the point of dreaming small? And then just follow directions!"

Eligibility: Student MUST...

- ...Be an African American individual;
- ...Be resident of Princeville, North Carolina;
- ...Be current, graduating senior in the Princeville, N.C. area;
- ...Be enrolled full-time (12 hours or more) in an accredited, tax-exempt school or institution of higher learning in North Carolina;
- ...Have earned a minimum GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale;
- ...Be pursuing studies in a trade/vocational/technical school, or arts/sciences in college/university.

Selection Criteria based on:

- *Residence;
- *School Attendance;
- *Letters of Recommendation (2);
- *School Activities Involvement;
- *Non-Academic/Athletic activities involvement;
- *Financial Need.

REQUIRED 500 word ESSAY:

The scholarship selection committee presents 3 Questions/Topics for your consideration:

- 1) How has Covid19 impacted you, how have you handled it, and what have you learned from the pandemic?
- 2) How do you feel about the Town of Princeville, about Princeville's history, and how you believe you can contribute to the Princeville community?
- 3) Where do you see yourself in the future, including future goals, and how will receiving the scholarship funds help meet those goals?

As an important part of the scholarship application the following is **required:**

- 1) **Select 1 (one)** of the 3 topics above that you like best or that applies most to your life, then...
- 2) Write a 500 word ESSAY describing how your selected topic applies to your thinking, beliefs and your life. The essay can be typed or hand-written.

Scholarship Awards:

- *Scholarship Candidates will have their applications reviewed and ranked by the designated Princeville Youth Advisory Board.
- *The scholarship winners and the alternatives for the scholarships will be selected from the screened applications by the designated Board members and Ms. Jane E. Ryan.
- *The scholarship awards of \$600. for each scholarship, will be awarded at the beginning of the <u>first</u> semester of the <u>first</u> year of higher education.
- *Scholarship winners and alternatives will be contacted and announced by July 2021 or earlier.

Required Materials for Application:

- <u>--Attach--</u> your hand-written or typed 500 word ESSAY. (See description of this required assignment above)
- <u>--Include--</u> two (2) *Letters of Recommendation* (one must come from a non-school representative and both letters must come from individuals who are NOT a family relative of the candidate).
- <u>--Collect--</u> All the required signatures and dates.
